Residents that have ordered new garden waste bins, they are on there way but there was an issue with supply. Bulky waste collections are currently suspended and the recycling centres are currently closed. Should resident be self isolating they must follow the government guidelines on waste disposal.

All day everyday key workers in the NHS, Police and Fire Service will take priority ahead of queues into our stores upon showing a valid ID. This is in addition to early access on a Sunday, where they can enter stores 30 minutes prior to opening. Also opening 30 minutes early Monday - Saturday for the Elderly (over 70) and vulnerable.

Due to unprecedented demand, they have made some changes to online orders and usual delivery services. They have extended delivery time frame for all deliveries to 3 to 10 working days.

Food banks are designed to provide short-term, emergency support with food during a crisis. Their aim is to relieve the immediate pressure of the crisis by providing food, while also providing additional support to help people resolve the crises that they face.

when emailing tenants must provide the following information: name, address, contact number, number of people in household and ages of any children, information about benefits received, why they require assistance, do they receive any help from another agency and who their landlord is.

They are currently operating on a Tuesday and Friday morning and they aim to deliver parcels between 11am and 1pm. Parcels will be left on the door step. If a contact number has been provided they will text. Alternatively they will knock on the door and walk away to a safe distance and wait for the parcel to be collected.

When you contact a foodbank direct, inform them you are a PA Housing resident. We have agreements with many foodbanks and it may assist them in deciding whether they can help you.



The Trussell Trust covers approximately 75% of the Foodbanks across the UK. Should you require flea and worming treatments then email the centre and they will arrange to post these to you.

- Acute sudden onset lameness
- Animals with chronic diseases who become unwell
- Birthing difficulties
- Breathing difficulties
- Severe bleeding
- Trauma cases
- Acute non-weight bearing lameness
- Severe vomiting or diarrhoea

- Any case that one of our vets has requested to see

Poorly puppies will be seen however new vaccination courses will not be started, existing ones will be completed.

Their website states the following:

- We collect all patients from the car park or front garden. We provide a disinfected lead for all dogs and disinfect cat boxes on collection and return.
- Clients are asked to no longer enter the building.
- We examine and treat your pet in our disinfected consulting room with you on the phone to discuss your and your pet's needs.
- We have reduced the number of clients we see per hour. This allows us to fully disinfect all contact points between clients.
- We are using single use protective equipment for all patients seen so we cannot transfer disease between clients.
- We are assessing patient care requirements and where possible providing these remotely via video link or telephone (telemedicine).
- We are using contactless payments over the phone for all payments. If cash is the only option it is bagged and taken out of circulation for a week.
- We are disinfecting all client equipment (leads, cat boxes) left at the practice during hospital visits before returning to the owner.
- We are questioning all clients for signs of ill health that might point to Coronavirus and making alternative arrangements for their pet care if they are considered an enhanced risk.
